Junior Field Trip

OBJECTIVE: Your class will participate in a fun hour-long introduction to Zeum’s activities and exhibit spaces, catered especially for our younger participants (from ages 3 to 7). Your assigned Zeum Educator will begin by leading your students through an interactive set of art-making, music and/or storytime activities; these activities take place in our Animators’ Studio, Music Production Lab, Artists’ Annex and/or Digital Workshop.

- **Literacy Skills** – students will listen to stories as they build formal and informal vocabulary and learn how to play with language through rhyme and dramatization
- **Motor Skills** – students will experiment with large and small muscle development, experimenting with locomotor movement or modeling clay
